Past Simple and Present Perfect (Simple and Continuous)

The <u>Past Simple</u> is used to talk about completed actions at a particular point im the past, often with dates or time. often with dates or times and words like

Kurt went to Canada in 1991.

vesterday, last and ago

I didn't see you yesterday. Where were you? The Present Perfect Simple is used to talk about

a) recent actions or events when no fixed time is given (e.g. news reports) often with word. with words like

just, recently and lately I've just seen your mother in the street

- b) actions which have a result in the present: What's wrong? Have you lost your keys?
- c) actions in a period of time which is not yet finished, and experiences in someone's life so yet, so jar, ever, never, for and since
- I haven't had any letters this week. (Compare : I had five letters last week) The Present Perfect Continuous is used to talk about actions which started in the past and are still happening, or which have recently stopped but have a result in the present:

 I've been waiting here for ten minutes. Your eyes are red. Have you been crying?
