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USING this resource

- Print a copy of the basket template for each student. Use page 4 for US spelling and page 5 for Australian spelling.
- Students will then colour, cut and glue their mini Easter basket together.
- Some younger students may need assistance to glue the tabs and the handle.
- For Kindergarten or First Grade students you might like to enlarge the page to A3 size to make it easier for them to cut and assemble.
- Add some feathers to the back of the basket if desired!
- You might like to have students take their baskets home. Alternatively, have them leave the baskets in your classroom before the Easter holiday and when students return, hopefully the Easter Bunny has left some treats!
- Use the bonus writing prompts as a fun activity when making the Easter baskets! There are 3 options to choose from, some with different line styles.







Directions:

- 1. Color your basket and handle.
- 2. Carefully cut along the dark black lines.
- 3. Fold outwards along the dotted lines.

- 5. Stick the tabs behind the squares.
