1. Giving your opinion neutrally	<p>I think...</p> <p>I feel that...</p> <p>In my opinion...</p> <p>As far as I'm concerned...</p> <p>As I see it...</p> <p>In my view...</p> <p>I tend to think that</p>
2. Asking someone's opinion	<p>What do you think?</p> <p>What's your view?</p> <p>How do you see the situation?</p> <p>What's your opinion?</p> <p>What are your ideas?</p> <p>Do you have any thoughts on that?</p> <p>How do you feel about that?</p>
3. Agreeing with an opinion	<p>Of course.</p> <p>You're absolutely right.</p> <p>Yes, I agree.</p> <p>I think so too.</p> <p>That's a good point.</p> <p>Exactly.</p> <p>I don't think so either.</p> <p>So do I.</p> <p>That's true.</p> <p>Neither do I.</p>
4. Disagreeing with an opinion	<p>That's different.</p> <p>I don't agree with you.</p> <p>However...</p> <p>That's not entirely true.</p> <p>On the contrary...</p> <p>I'm sorry to disagree with you, but...</p> <p>Yes, but don't you think...</p> <p>That's not the same thing at all.</p> <p>I'm afraid I have to disagree.</p> <p>I'm not so sure about that.</p> <p>I must take issue with you on that.</p> <p>It's unjustifiable to say that...</p>
