His famous last words were, "Don't disturb my

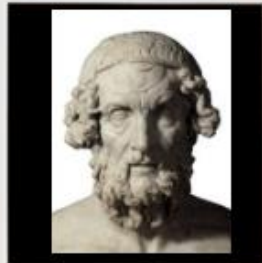
