- ghosts [n] = spirits of dead people who stay on earth because they have unfinished business
[φαντάσματα]
- haunted [adj] = a place where a ghost lives, e.g. a haunted house *[στοιχειωμένο σπίτι]*
- a couple [n] = ζευγάρι
- horse carriage = an old-fashioned car pulled by horses *[άμαξα]*
- shelter [n] = protection, a safe place *[καταφύγιο]*
- immediately [adv] = right now *[αμέσως]*
- disturb [vb] = ενοχλώ
- turn in [phr] = go to bed
- luxurious [adj] = comfortable and expensive, e.g. a *luxurious five-star hotel* *[πολυτελής]*
- cosy [adj] = warm and comfortable *[άνετος]*
- delicious [adj] = very tasty *[πεντανόστιμος]*
- miss [vb] = not do or not see, e.g. *I missed the English lesson this week* *[χάνω κάτι, δεν κάνω κάτι]*
- mistaken [adj] = wrong
- track [n] = the road, the path *[μονοπάτι]*

- ruins [n] = what is left of a destroyed building
[ερείπια]
- greedy [adj] = a person who wants to have everything *[άπληστος]*
