

Talking about the future



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Future Simple: Will (form)

- Affirmative: He **will travel** by train
- Interrogative: **Will he travel** by bus?
- Negative: **No, he will not.** → **No, he won't.**



will/ going to



Oh! This photo looks lovely! I **will go** to Paris next year.

1.decision-απόφαση **at that moment**



I **am going to** study French this summer.

(future plan= μελλοντικό σχέδιο)

We can use both **will** & **going to** with a slight change of meaning.



We **will** probably **go** to Rome next summer. (not sure)

We **are going to** fly to Rome next week. (we have already arranged it=το έχουμε κανονίσει)

Other uses of will



2. Threat/warning

(απειλή/προειδοποίηση)

- If you don't clean up, you **won't play** with your tablet.



3. Prediction (πρόβλεψη)

- It **will rain** in the evening.
(based on what we think)

4.Promise

➤ Don't worry! I **will help** you.



5. Request =παράκληση

➤ **Will you** please **run** or we **will miss our flight.**



6. Offer= προσφορά

➤ I **will help** you plant the new flowers.



7. Suggestion= πρόταση

➤ **Shall we eat** out tonight?



Time expressions

tomorrow, next week ,this summer, next year...

Present Continuous

Future arrangements we have already done, usually for the near future.

- She **is travelling** to Porto at the weekend.

Present Simple

Timetables & fixed future events

- The boat **leaves** at 10.00 sharp.
