Writing Tip Setting the scene

We start our story by setting the scene. To do so, we describe the main characters (*who*), the place (*where*), the time (*when*), the characters' activities (*what*), the weather and their feelings.



Writing Tip Sequence words

We use appropriate linking words (*when, and, after, later, finally, as soon as, at the moment, while, etc.*) to show the sequence of events in a story. *He entered the hotel. He saw a woman waiting for him. – When he entered the hotel, he saw a woman waiting for him.*
